Day 1

Hotel: The Cumberland Hotel

Day 2

Hotel: The Cumberland Hotel

We visit the Tower of London where you will see the Crown Jewels, and finish our tour with a Thames River Cruise. (B)

Day 3

Hotel: The Cumberland Hotel

This morning, visit the London Transport Museum. Based in Covent Garden, the museum seeks to conserve and explain the transport heritage of London. Step back in time looking at the exhibits which provide a history of London through its transportation. Return to your hotel where this evening is at leisure. (B)

Day 4

ROYAL AIR FORCE MUSEUM

Hotel: The Cumberland Hotel

Today is dedicated to visiting The Royal Air Force Museum, situated on what used to be RAF Hendon. It is Britain's only national museum dedicated wholly to aviation. With a world-class aircraft collection, integrated with special exhibitions, films, interactives, artwork, engines, missile, photographs, uniforms, medals and research and education facilities, the Museum takes an innovative approach while keeping with tradition. After plenty of time to explore, return to your hotel. Tonight, dinner at a typical London pub. (B, HD)

Day 5

LONDON – PORTSMOUTH

Hotel: Langstone Hotel

Depart London and travel to Portsmouth. En route, enjoy the English countryside before arriving in Hampshire and the port city of Portsmouth. After an orientation tour, settle into your hotel. (B, D)

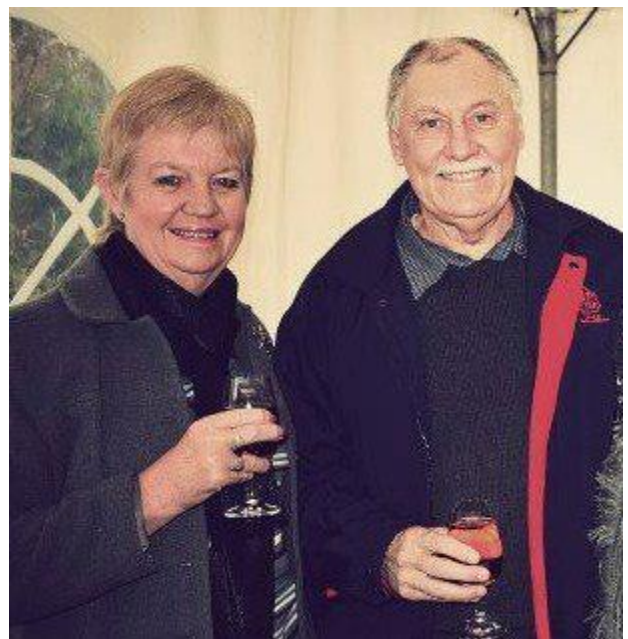

Day 8 **NATIONAL MOTOR MUSEUM BEAULIEU**

Hotel: Langstone Hotel

Travel to Beaulieu to visit The National Motor Museum. From the earliest motor carriages to classic family saloons, the National Motor Museum boasts one of the finest collections of cars, motorcycles and motoring memorabilia in the world. There are more than 250 vehicles to tell the story of motoring on the roads of Britain, from pioneering origins to the present day. The stylish, the elegant, the fast, the famous and the plain functional are all on show at what is the most well renowned motor museum in the UK. After ample time to explore, return to Portsmouth for dinner at a local restaurant. (B, HD)

Day 9 **HAYNES INTERNATIONAL MOTOR MUSEUM**

Hotel: Carlyon Bay Hotel St Austell

We depart Portsmouth and travel first to Sparkford for a visit to the Haynes International Motor Museum. The Museum is the UK's collection of the greatest cars from around the world with over 400 amazing cars and bikes on show. We take a guided tour of the exhibits before continuing to our hotel in St Austell on the Cornish Coast. (B, D)

Day 10 **EXPLORING THE CORNISH COAST**

Hotel: Carlyon Bay Hotel St Austell

Explore the rugged Cornish Coast today, famous for smugglers' coves and quaint fishing villages. Stop for a photo of St Michael's Mount near Penzance before continuing to Land's End, the most westerly point of the British mainland. Then visit St. Ives, a beautiful resort popular with artists and tourists before returning to St. Austell. (B)

Day 11 **BATH, MALVERN REGION**

Hotel: Queens Hotel Cheltenham

We farewell the Cornish coast and travel north. Stop in Bath where we visit the Roman Baths, before travelling through the Cotswolds to our base in Cheltenham. (B, D)

Day 12 **MORGAN FACTORY**

Hotel: Queens Hotel Cheltenham

For over 100 years, the Morgan Motor Company have been making exciting sports cars in the beautiful spa town of Malvern. Experience the passion yourself with a factory tour and visit to the on-site museum before returning to the hotel in Cheltenham. (B)

Day 13 **CHELtenham – PARIS**

Hotel Meridien Etoile or similar

Travel through the English countryside to London for your Eurostar trip to Paris. On arrival, an orientation tour shows you the imposing facades of the Louvre, the banks of the Seine with its romantic bridges, the obelisk in the centre of the Place de la Concorde and drive along the Champs Elysees to the Arc de Triumph. Today is set aside for you to explore Paris as you wish. Perhaps ascend the Eiffel Tower or visit one of the many museums and art galleries. Your Tour Director will be able to assist with suggestions. (B)

Day 15 **PARIS – MULHOUSE**

Hotel: Mercure Mulhouse

Travel to Mulhouse in regional France near the border with Switzerland and to many to visit the Schlumpf Collection in Cité de l'Automobile. The Museum has been built around the Schlumpf Collection of Classic automobiles. It has the largest displayed collection of automobiles and contains the most comprehensible collection of Bugatti motor vehicles in the world! (B)

Day 16 **MULHOUSE – BASEL – ZURICH**

Hotel: Zurich Hotel TBA

Cross the Swiss border and travel first to Basel for an orientation. We continue and take time out for a cheese tasting before heading into Zurich. Tonight, a farewell dinner at a local restaurant to celebrate our time in Europe. (B, FD)
